BC Ambulance Service (BCAS) Fleet Operations is responsible for the design, purchase, lease and maintenance of all BCAS vehicles including the management of a comprehensive ambulance preventative maintenance program and safety audit program and has the following career opportunity available.

Superintendent, Fleet Operations

As Superintendent, your major responsibility will be to manage the vehicle design process and tendering /procurement process for ambulances that make up the BCAS fleet. Reporting to the Director, you will also be responsible for fleet safety and will oversee the operational functions of planning and coordinating vehicle moves to accommodate routine or emergency servicing and refurbishment functions.

To be successful in this role, you will have a working knowledge of the Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Standards requirements and have proven that you can collaborate with stakeholders to address design, procurement, safety and performance issues. You find the balance between operational requirements, safety, and client needs and consistently engage employees and stakeholders to develop service delivery options and implement effective business processes and systems that meet or exceed expectations. You have experience managing capital and operational budgets, can bring complex procurement processes to conclusion and have developed policies and procedures. Preference will be given to applicants with a post secondary degree in business or a related field who have at least two years in progressively responsible management positions. Experience working for an emergency services organization is desired. Applicants with an equivalent combination of education and experience in fleet management are encouraged to apply.

BC Ambulance Services operates under authority of the Emergency and Health Services Commission to deliver ground and air ambulance service to the people of British Columbia. The provincial call volume for the BC Ambulance Service is approximately 516,000 calls annually, ranking the BCAS as one of the largest ambulance authorities in North America, and the largest in Canada. Fleet Operations is one of the operating divisions within Provincial Programs and is responsible for over 500 active ambulances and emergency support vehicles in 187 stations throughout the province. Provincial Programs also has responsibility for all air ambulance operations for BCAS; provincial governance and quality management for the critical care transport program; the development and management of the BCAS disaster preparedness program; and is responsible for creating and maintaining work schedules for all the full-time, multi-station posts in the province.
